Students who can't get their parents' info for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) can ask for an Unsubsidized Federal Direct Loan, but only if their parents say they won't give the info or help. If students go this route, they can't get grants, work study jobs, or subsidized loans. Also, their parents can't borrow Federal PLUS Loans.
