If your enrollment level changes in the first two weeks of the quarter, you don't have to pay back financial aid from state grants or scholarships. These include the Washington College Grant, College Bound Scholarship, and Passport to Careers. You won't need to repay what went towards your tuition or what you received directly, but there's still an impact. If you decide not to pay it back, the full amount you got will be taken from your future funding from these sources. You'll also need to submit this form to the Financial Aid Office of Green River College before you can get more funding.

By signing this form, I agree to the following:

- I attended at least one session for all the classes I was enrolled in when my financial aid was applied this quarter. Since then, I dropped one or more classes. I know this changes how much financial aid I can get.
- I don't want to pay back the money I got from Washington state programs. I know this will affect how much more money I can get from Washington state grants and scholarships in the future.
- The GRC Financial Aid staff can decide to deny this request. If that happens, I won't be able to get more state aid until I finish one quarter (at least 5 credits) without it. I can appeal this decision.
- This form only makes me eligible for state money again. I might still have to pay back federal money like Pell grants. And if I didn't do well enough in my classes, I'll have to ask separately to keep getting aid, following GRC rules.
