



PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT PROGRAM

Thank you for your interest in Green River College's PTA program! The PTA program starts once a year in the fall. This is a full-time program (classes take place any time between 7am and 5 pm) and the program takes two years to complete. During the last quarter of the curriculum, students will be placed in full-time clinical rotations (40 hours a week).

PTA PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

<input type="checkbox"/> Anatomy and Physiology 1 (AP 103 or BIOL& 241) *	(5) Credit course. Minimum GPA Required: 2.5
<input type="checkbox"/> Anatomy and Physiology 2 (AP 104 or BIOL& 242) *	(5) Credit course. Minimum GPA Required: 2.5
<input type="checkbox"/> English Composition (ENGL&101)	(5) Credit course. Minimum GPA Required: 2.5
<input type="checkbox"/> Communications course (CMST 100, or &210, or &220, or &230, or &238)	(5) Credit course. Minimum GPA Required: 2.5. Only 1 communications course is needed
<input type="checkbox"/> College Level Math Course (Any college level math course excluding technical math) *Anatomy & Physiology (A&P) courses have a 7 year expiration date. In order to take AP 103, students need to be eligible for English& 101. AP 103 does not transfer. In order to take BIOL& 241, students need to complete Bio 160 (general Biology). BIOL& 241 and BIOL& 242 are transferrable. *A&P Courses have to be taken in sequence at the same institution.	(5) Credit course. Minimum GPA Required: 2.5 Any of these courses will satisfy the requirement: Math 107, Math 146, Math 141, Math 142, Math 151, Math 152, Math 153, Math 171. For a complete list, contact the Health Occupations Advisor.

- ✓Applications open middle of **March and are due middle of April every year**
- ✓All courses need to be completed with a minimum grade of 2.5
- ✓One prerequisite course may be in progress at the time of application

APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

- Complete all prerequisites with a minimum grade of 2.5
- Complete a minimum of 20 or more hours of job shadowing in at least 2 different physical therapy settings*. Please have the clinician complete the Verification and Recommendation form for each setting (this form is available on the website).
*It is strongly recommended applicants complete at least 20 hours in EACH of three different settings (outpatient, skilled nursing facility, hospital, rehab center, schools, etc.)
- If you have taken courses or completed a degree at a different institution, send your official transcripts to enrollment services AND fill out a [Transcript Evaluation Request form](#). (If you do not fill out this form, your transcript will not be evaluated). Students with international transcripts need to first evaluate their transcript through a third party evaluator (check www.fis-web.com for a list of approved accreditors)

- Resume
